Irresistible...

This wine combines two seemingly opposite grapes: 100-year-old Grenache and young Syrah. However, these two varieties complement one another beautifully: a fusion of masculine and feminine – a silky blend of power and finesse with fresh fruit aromas, flowers and spices.

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B L E N D

50% Syrah

from the Cabrieres plot, which gives fruit, power, color and cocoa aromas.

50% Grenache

from our 100-year-old plots of Grand Pierre/Rayas, Palestor and Terres Blanches blocks. Wine from these grapes has considerable finesse and silkiness.



WINE-MAKING AND AGING

Gravity-flow underground winery for gentle handling. Wine-making in tulip-shaped concrete tanks.

Destemming of underripe stalks. The wine stays on the skins for over 4 weeks. Gentle extractions. Aging in 600l barrels for 20 months. The wine is not filtered before bottling.

V I T I C U L T U R E

Rigorous bud pruning. Furthermore, green harvesting and leaf thinning are done.

The picking is entirely by hand, with sorting in the vineyard and again in the cellar.

CARLOS PAZOS

This label was designed by Barcelona artist Carlos Pazos, who was awarded Spain's 2004 Plastic Arts Prize. He is a great lover of France, where he works a good part of the year. Carlos' drawing beautifully expresses the synergy of this unique blend from Domaine la Barroche.
